Bio of our featured speaker...



Minister Lee J. Wilder, a native of Reading, Pennsylvania, was born March 19, 1957. He has resided in Berks and Schuylkill counties his entire life. Minister Lee has four children, Robert, Sheree', Elizabeth and Trevoun and eight grandchildren.

Minister Lee obtained his primary and secondary education within the Reading School District completing high school. While attending Reading High School he was active in the Music Department; participating in orchestra, school shows, concert band, spirit band and marching band. He was the percussion section leader and composed the scores for the entire percussion section of the Red Knight Marching Band. He entered Kutztown State College as an aspiring freshman. His focus was Political Science and Music. He also attended Liberty University, Lynchburg, Virginia majoring in Religious Studies and University of Phoenix Online, Phoenix, AZ majoring in Business and Finance.

Musically he has accomplished many aspirations. He has performed at many venues, including The Apollo Theatre and The Cotton Club in New York City. Minister Lee has been a member of several musical organizations including the Reading Community Gospel Choir, The Shades of Gray, The New Beginning Choir, several marching units, and We Three Gospel Jazz Band.

He accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Savior as a teenager, as a member of St. James Church of God in Christ in Reading, PA. There he served in the Music Ministry and later was a Trustee. He later was a member of Zion Baptist Church where he was active in the music ministry, Bible study teacher and Minister in Training.

He was one of the founding members of New Beginnings Christian Life Fellowship Church in Reading, PA. Under Pastor Raymond C. Bland's training, Minister Lee experienced a ministry founded upon the principles of prayer, faith, giftedness, worship and teaching the Word of God. He also served as the Church Administrator. On November 11, 2012, Minister Lee offered his Initial Sermon at New Beginnings Christian Life Fellowship Church.

The Holy Spirit has recently lead Minister Lee to return and serve as Associate Minister at St. James Chapel, where his Christian experience first began. He currently serves on the Ministerial Staff and the Pastor's Aid Committee. He is also currently the Community Resource Manager of Family Promise of Berks County. FPB partners with local communities and networks of volunteers to provide services to homeless families, youth and individuals facing a housing crisis.
