

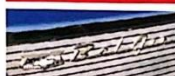

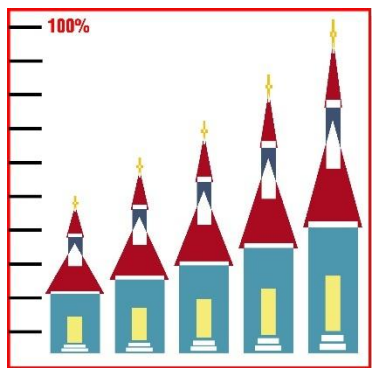

## CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

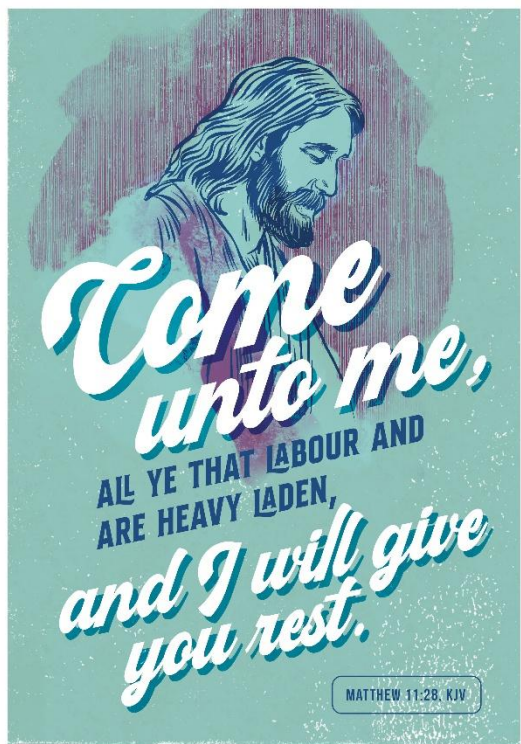
How many times have you heard someone say, “I love Calvary Church”? Do they mean they love the building, the people in the congregation, the ideas that our United Methodist Church stands for, maybe all the above? Well, our church and parsonage are now 94 years old, and they could use some love in the form of maintenance, repair, and sprucing up in many areas. After extensive walk throughs and careful observation by our trustees and vitality and sustainability team over 150 items for attention were discovered. Some will require professional attention, some may require skills such as patching and painting, and some just involve cleaning and organizing.

The gift tree in our narthex will contain cards describing many of the jobs to be done. We are encouraging our members to choose a card(s) and complete the task to be done. You can assemble your own crew if needed but many are one or two person jobs. There will be some jobs that require funds to complete, and we ask that you make that financial commitment to complete that task. You may choose to do this in lieu of (or in addition to) a direct contribution to the capital campaign that we hope will cover the majority of expenses needed to make our facilities safer and more pleasing in appearance.

Should you choose to donate your financial resources to this project please send your checks to the church office with “Capital Campaign” noted on the memo line. We will need to reach a goal of \$100,000 before Thanksgiving to ensure the success of this undertaking so we are striving for 100% participation from our members.

Thanks in advance for your willingness to help Calvary succeed in providing a place of worship which is beautiful, safe, and energy efficient as we strive to thrive as a spiritual community.
