

#### **Calvary's Capital Campaign Funds at Work**

Even though Calvary's Capital Campaign is running through Thanksgiving, some much needed repairs to the church building have already begun with the use of those funds. In an effort to keep the congregation apprised of these vital repairs, the Trustees will be reporting the status of various projects as they are completed.

In this week's Calvary Connection, completed electrical work to the main service panels is being highlighted. The old service panels, located in the downstairs boiler room, were outdated, and finding needed replacement parts had become impossible. Two new circuit panels and all necessary breakers were installed, and all existing lines were relocated to the new panels. This work was done by D. S. Burkholder Electrical in Denver, PA at a cost of \$3,600.
