



Here's the latest update on our capital campaign as of Sunday October 26. It's a good news bad news scenario...the good news is that we are 2/3 of the way towards our goal. We have about \$65,000 of the \$100,000 we need. The bad news is that as of November 2 our campaign is supposed to end. The good news is that as of this date 23% of our giving units have responded so the 77% who have yet to contribute should easily push us over our goal. The bad news is that maybe they won't respond and we will have a historically low turnout to support this essential fund-raising effort.

I'm reminded of attending First Missionary Baptist Church in Biloxi MS during a Katrina mission trip. The pastor had put out a plea for the congregation to financially support the youth group's participation in an important event. In Pastor Dickey's words the congregation's efforts were "a dismal failure". With renewed enthusiasm he stated that the congregation would be "reminded" of the goal every week until it was reached. Using his example, we will extend our campaign to the original date of Thanksgiving instead of the end of October. Rather than a weekly reminder from the lectern, consider this update as a renewed plea for your participation in this essential project.

Thank you to those who have already responded. If you have not yet contributed, and if you are able to, please send your check to the church (or place in the Sunday offering) with "Capital Campaign" noted in the memo line.

#### What you need:

- Construction paper in a variety of fall colors
- · Pencil, marker, or crayons
- Yarn, ribbon, or raffia
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Spray bottle filled with water
- Real leaves (Optional)
- Wooden or plastic beads, 🕦 🕜 cereal with holes (Cheerios, Froot Loops, etc.), or any dried pasta with a hole (Optional)

#### What you do:

- 1. Draw or trace leaf shapes onto construction paper.
- 2. Lay the paper flat and spray with water until the paper is completely
- 3. Crumple the wet paper into balls.
- 4. Open the paper and let the sheets
- 5. When dry, cut out each leaf.
- 6. On each leaf, write the name of one person or thing you're thankful for.
- 7. Punch a hole in each leaf.
- 8. Lace the leaves, beads, cereal, and pasta onto the yarn, ribbon, or raffia.
- 9. Tie the ends and hang your garland.
