


Please join us for our non-competitive bowling group each Tuesday of the week at Berks Lanes. Practice begins at 6:20PM.

The Reverse Advent Calendar turns this tradition around. Instead of receiving a gift, you participate by donating and "Giving" an item each day to the food bank. 


