In recent postings, most of the reflections have been on physical elements of worship. I invite you to reflect this week on the spiritual element of worship

Consider for a moment that in Christianity, God's presence in worship refers to the belief that God is spiritually near and actively involved when we gather to pray, sing, hear scripture, and celebrate the sacraments. So, here's my question. *When was the last time YOU felt God's presence in worship?* Worship is not only about people speaking to God — it is also about God meeting with, and in many instances, speaking to His people.

So how might we go about experiencing God's presence in worship? Here are a few possibilities:

Through Scripture: As Christians, hopefully we believe God speaks to us through the Bible when scripture is read and preached. As scripture is read, can you envision the environment during the period those words were inspired? Can you grasp the significance of the times God came to the aid of our forefathers?

Through prayer: Our worship flow hopefully creates a time of communion and relationship with God. While it is not humanly impossible, can you sense that God can and does listen to ALL of our individual communications with Him?

Through music and praise: Songs and hymns that have been written by others express adoration, thanksgiving, confession, and hope. Can you relate to those senses? What a gift to have hymns that have been written many years ago that are meaningful to us and also have the blessing of current day believers who continue to write new music inspired by their relationship with Jesus Christ.

Through the gathered community: Jesus taught that He is present among believers gathered in His name. When you enter the Sanctuary, have you taken the time to extend your appreciation for being in His midst? In addition to fellowship, does respect for the purpose of worship still resonate in your hearts and minds?

Through the sacraments: Our two sacrament (Baptism and Communion) are especially structured to emphasize God's presence. We just recently had the opportunity to share in Baptism. Plus, our current tradition is to celebrate Communion the first Sunday of each month, as well as special occasions. When we celebrate Communion, are you able to appreciate the amazing sacrifice made in our behalf?

One last consideration: In Matthew 18:20 we read: "For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them." Have you made an effort to feel His presence as we gather to worship?
